



NorthStar will have a new program for the 2018-2019 school year. We will be offering our families a blended program. A blended program combines the benefits of parent directed home education with the advantages of teacher directed and online programming. In the past NSA parents have had to choose either a traditional home education program (parent directed) or a fully aligned program (online or teacher directed). We will now be able to offer the opportunity for a student to be a part of both of these worlds. There are some boundaries, so we will provide all the details in the days ahead, but here are the basics:

- Grades 1-9 Aligned portion of the program must be 50% or higher
- Grades 10-12 Aligned portion of the program must be 20% or higher








Bible Verses Easter

- Matthew 20:18-19 18 "We are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and the teachers of the law. They will condemn him to death 19 and will hand him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified. On the third day he will be raised to life!"
- Luke 23: 46-47 46 Jesus called out with a loud voice, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit." When he had said this, he breathed his last.
 47 The centurion, seeing what had happened, praised God and said, "Surely this was a righteous man."
- Mark 16:1-4 1When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. 2 Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb 3 and they asked each other, "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?" 4 But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away.
- Mark 16: 5-6 5 As they entered the tomb, they saw a young man dressed in a white robe sitting on the right side, and they were alarmed.
 6 "Don't be alarmed," he said. "You are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid him.
