These upgrades allow for us to add new features to our Moodle such as the new navigation bar that toggles on and off and the links in the title bar. One of those links is PowerSchool, which takes you to the student/parent portal where you can access the latest information on your child's progress in his/her classes. An email was sent out with your log in information, but if you need any assistance with getting into the portal, just call the office.

We have had lots of questions about summer school but unfortunately, we don't have any definite answers yet. The changes Alberta Education introduced to the way senior high students are funded (45 credit cap) have led to concerns about whether or not we can operate summer school, since we don't know for sure we will receive funding for any classes we offer in July. We hope to hear from Alberta Education regarding their plan by May 1st.

Please join us in continuing to pray for the families touched by the Humboldt Broncos bus crash. The scope of this tragedy is such that its impact is being felt by many, many people. One of the side effects of being in education for a long time (32 years for me) is that the loss of young lives is familiar; rare but familiar. One funeral is too many – 15 young lives lost is hard to comprehend. May God have mercy.

A blended program combines the benefits of parent directed home education with the advantages of teacher directed and online programming. In the past NSA parents have had to choose either a traditional home education program (parent directed) or a fully aligned program (online or teacher directed). We will now be able to offer the opportunity for a student to be a part of both of these worlds. There are some boundaries, so we will provide all the details in the days ahead, but here are the basics:

- Grades 1-9 Aligned portion of the program must be 50% or higher
- Grades 10-12 Aligned portion of the program must be 20% or higher
