



Matthew 22:34-40

- 35 And one of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question to test Him.
- 36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?"
- 37 And He said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.
- 38 This is the great and first commandment.

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2020 Europe Trip

Almost two millennia since Paul journeyed to Athens and Rome to spread the Gospel, a group of students, parents, and staff from PCA will be headed in the same direction. The trip will include the sights and sounds of Rome, Capri, Sorrento, Pompeii, Delphi, and Athens, while hitting many lovely places in between. For ten days we will travel through some of the most beautiful locations, view Classical and Renaissance art and architecture, and even traverse the very locales and reference points of the early Church. Every student will have a chance to apply and enhance their understanding of the Social Studies and Bible courses in a very real and practical way. There is something to be said for standing on the very ground where Paul preached, rather than just talking about it from more than 8000Km away.
