We are grateful that we work for the Golden Hills School Division as their careful planning for September means that we have not had to deal with possible layoffs and cutbacks in the midst of the school year. There are still some uncertainties going forward as Alberta Education is making some changes including revamping the funding model they use to support school divisions but on the good news side there is clear evidence of support for parental choice in education. For us at NorthStar the good news is two fold with support for choosing Christian education and for choosing to partner with us as you educate your children from home.

We are close to wrapping up our first semester courses for our grade 10-12 students and the grade 12's diploma exams begin next week. Please join us in praying that these students will have safe travel as they head to write the tests and that the hard work they have invested in these courses will bring answers to mind – the right ones!


29. Then God said, "I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food...
