

Eden Lake Ski Resort

Lake Eden, north-west of Edmonton, was originally named by the Lake Eden Fur Farm that operated a farm on the lands close to the Lake until 1970 when it sold

The business minded Zeiter brothers had a dream of developing a year-round summer and winter resort, and boy, did they build one.

They built summer cabins and rented them out to families from looking for a lake getaway.

They even piled 28,000 cubic meters of dirt on the hill to raise the vertical descent from 25 meters to 62 meters.

However, the Zeiter brothers had their misfortunes, and Lake Eden, and their other assets were placed in receivership.


In 1983 the Lake Eden property was sold.

The ski area continued to operate until the mid 1990s, when rising costs and bad winters forced the property to close once and for all.

The lodge, which had been a dangerous hazard, was torched in December 2012.

All that remains of the once prominent Eden Lake resort are a chairlift, T-bars, a few dilapidated cabins, and a few ski runs.

The hill can also be seen from the Trans Canada highway.


"Only a few more days until our first class!" I excitedly said after a little while, closing my laptop and looking at my friends with a wide grin. I couldn't wait!
