## HOME ENVIRONMENT AND LEARNING IDEAS FOR PARENTS

#### Setting up Success!

- 1. Establishing a schedule.
- 2. Arrange an appropriate place for learning.
- 3. Gathering the resources and tech required.

All of these things are absolutely essential in being able to get a solid start to a school year at NorthStar Academy. But even more important ... starting the year with the readiness to learn. Beyond the practical examples we just listed, students will need to feel known, heard, seen, supported, and safe.

With learning happening from a distance, students can feel isolated and believe there is no one to support them. They need to know they have someone to go to when they are struggling or feel confused or frustrated. Online learning requires more attention, focus, independence, and motivation than traditional classroom learning environments. They don't have a peer or teacher physically present who can recognize the frustration and support them through it. Although they can reach out virtually to either, the responses are delayed and distant.

A supportive parent or supervisor at home is the key to setting our students up for success. Here are some ways parents and supervisors can support their student at home:

- be available to help with questions and encourage your student to reach out to their teacher when they are confused about their school work.
- stay calm so you can help them stay calm, stop and take 3 deep breaths or take a walk together and talk then come back to the issue and talk it through to discover the real issue to solve.
- monitor their attendance to learning students will need someone to make sure they are staying on task
- help create a structure to their day. Build a flexible, yet predictable routine. Include a simple list of activities that your student needs to complete each day.
- set goals and celebrate progress daily (even on not-so-good days) remembering its about progress and not perfection

#### YEARLY THEME: "CONNECTED, IN CHRIST"

With the past year and a half of dealing with CV-19 and the government restrictions on our lives, the importance and significance of relationships has made its way to the front of the class. God made us to be relational creatures. We see this right in the beginning of the Scriptures, where it says that God walked and talked with Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. Unfortunately, with Adam and Eve disobeying God, that relationship was broken. This past year, our relationships have been broken as well—with siblings, parents, aunts, uncles, cousins, grandparents, friends, acquaintances, etc. Broken relationships hurt, but they can be mended.

Thankfully, none of this has taken God by surprise.He is omniscient (all-knowing), and He knew that there would be a break in His relationship with people. Because He knew what was going to happen with Adam and Eve, He had a plan, even before Creation began, and that plan was beautiful.People confuse this plan by thinking that they can bridge the gap between us and God, that they can earn their way into Heaven, but that is not possible, because we are all sinful beings. The only way that the relationship could be restored is to have God look upon each one of us as pure and holy. No person can state that he or she is perfectly holy, or even that he or she is a truly good person, because we have all failed to keep God's Law. All of us have sinned at one point, or many points, in our lives, and the Bible says that if we break even one of God's commandments, then we are liable for breaking all of God's Law. So, in Old Testament times, specific animals were sacrificed as a substitute for a person's sin, but this was only a temporary "fix." There had to be a permanent solution, and that permanent solution happened close to 2,000 years ago.

When my son was a lot younger, he said very innocently, "You mean that God sent Himself?" How insightful can a child be? J Through the working of the Holy Spirit in a young lady named Mary, she conceived the Son of God—Jesus Christ! That young man grew up and lived a sinless life. Then, Jesus willingly laid down His life, as a substitute for man's sin, and took the judicious wrath of God, His Father, upon Himself, that was supposed to be for us. But, three days later, God raised Jesus from the dead, and He is now our perfect sacrifice, the One upon whom we can believe and have everlasting life. And how is that? Because Jesus took on the sin of the world, but more specifically, the sin of those who repent and believe on Him as their Lord and Saviour. In that way, Christian believers are Connected, "In Christ." We are brothers and sisters, through our risen Saviour. Praise our Risen Lord!
