Cyber Bullying continues to be a concern in our society. While NorthStar is a safe and caring place for students, we know that kids are pressured in many ways to do things that are harmful; sometimes to others and sometimes to themselves. The selfie generation can often find themselves taking pictures and sharing them in ways that are problematic, without ever thinking about the possible negative consequences. We have located a resource that may be of assistance to you as parents wanting to guide your child through this potential mine field. It is a small booklet entitled" School and Family Approaches to Intervention and Prevention: Addressing Self/Peer Exploitation". While it is not produced by a Christian publisher, most of its advice seems quite sound. We will get them to you as soon as they are delivered and we can figure out a good method.



As our school continues to grow we are looking to make sure that students don't fall through the cracks. We are setting up a "home room" or "guide teacher" concept in which each student is assigned to a teacher who will regularly make contact with them. Students who are doing a fully on-line program can have quite a few teachers so this home room will give them someone to connect with if they are needing some guidance. For traditional home school students and TD kids from grade 1-9, their facilitator will continue to be their main contact with NSA. For TD kids doing senior high classes, we currently have three teachers working in their area of expertise and one of those teachers will be assigned to each child, again as a point of contact and for someone to watch over their program.

NorthStar is a part of the Golden Hills School Division and while our Didsbury office is not within the GHSD boundaries, the board of trustees and superintendent guide our school. I invite you to attend a community meeting for GHSD schools to hear from the superintendent on Bill 10 (Gay - Straight Alliance Clubs and Anti-Bullying practices for LGBTQ students). Our area will be meeting on March 7th, at 7:00 pm in the Parable Place (on the Prairie campus in Three Hills). If you would like to attend call the NSA office and we will get you directions so you can find the right building.

18 And he is the head of the body, the church; he is the beginning and the firstborn from among the dead, so that in everything he might have the supremacy.


19 For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him,
