Message from the Principal

Last weekend I was at a trade show in Calgary helping to man the NorthStar booth. Across from us was a car dealership that had a big crew working. One of the individuals was a middle aged man who was dressed and made up as a woman. There have been a lot of conversations around gender identity issues recently in Alberta so you would think I would have a clear mindset to approach this situation but I have to admit that my historic biases jumped to the forefront. Negative thoughts, some bordering on ridicule, are what came to mind. I did eventually catch myself and stop to think of this person as someone in need of a Saviour, but I later realized that the rest of the dozen or so people working their booth were likely in the same place – struggling to find meaning in a life being lived without real purpose. Why did I not think to pray for them as I did for this one person?

I've been a Christian for a long time so I should be getting good at living out God's will for my life. Historically, the evangelical church hasn't done a great job in dealing with gender identity issues but I thought I was on track. Clearly I still have a way to go. It is our desire at NorthStar to be genuine followers of Christ who live according to all that God has revealed to us in His Scriptures. This is what we try to model for our students and what we encourage in them as well. In some ways this is a simple task but it can also be very complex. What attitudes do we bring to bear? Do we treat all those who don't know Jesus the same? Do we have compassion, do we show the love of Jesus, or do we respond to people so that they see condemnation as what we are about?

At NSA we truly do believe in the authority of the Bible and its ability to guide our lives. We also believe in the power of prayer so we ask you to pray for us as we seek to partner with you in leading your children into a closer walk with Christ. It can be challenging work but we are thankful for the opportunity and for your support.

November: Stand firm so you will not be a slave to sin

Galatians 5:1, 13-17

5 It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.



13 You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh [a]; rather, serve one another humbly in love. **14** For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." [b] **15** If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other.

16 So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. **17** For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever[c] you want.
